7.1	MB raised: Park off Cheyne Path has been "given" from Ealing Council to the Hanwell Big Local partnership but there is no formal agreement and funding for the upkeep. The nettle clear-out cost £7,000 per clearance operation in the past, pre-COVID, but the nettles have all grown back. Nigel from the Hanwell Big Local partnership would like to come to a future RA meeting to gather ideas from residents and get buy-in. The Partnership would like to upgrade the space for better use. Cllr RB will look into the Council partnering with the Hanwell Big Local partnership and discuss matching funding for the nettle clear-out but the ongoing upkeep will require active management and a formal agreement—MB notes that without something in writing, the funding cannot be sorted. Cllr RB will look into the formal handover agreement to help MB. MB will provide estimates for the improvement works, and had pursued previous planning for community artworks, benches, an outdoor stage, etc.  Observers from Matlock Court, parking spaces have been closed offpaid spaces/spaces without double yellows are getting tickets—Cllr RB will help, has requested a direct email from the observers.
